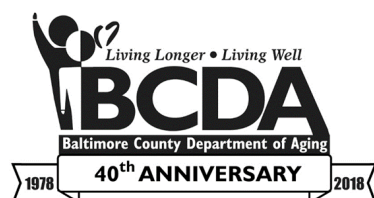
**Directions to Seven Oaks Senior Center:** Take I-695 to Exit 32 North, Belair Road.
